#### 2 - ASTI Meeting Update - Uachtarán and Leas Uachtarán

On the 14th of September, Uachtarán, Leas Uachtarán and Education Officer attended a meeting with the President of the Association of Secondary Teachers in Ireland, Miriam Duggan.

They discussed the work of both unions, and issues prevalent to the education stakeholder community.

#### 3 - Internal Policy Writing Working Group - International Officer

Following the OBESSU Summer Skills and discussions with fellow international officers, the International Officer proposes a working group with the ISSU to create internal policy. Many members of OBESSU have working groups designated for policies such as in Denmark and Bosnia, where there are representatives of each internal body that form said working group.

Uachtarán Oinigh - This sort of internal policy is not the remit or responsiabilty of the coiste gnó

International Officer - we have contacts with organisations that can assist but understands the constraints with this matter

Uachtarán - we could creating a working group to focus on some policies but suggests need to decide which ones

Runaí -suggests we decide over

Uachtarán Oinigh - this has been tried and tested. It is not the remit of the coiste gnó or regional officers. Suggests we seek CG training and revisit the topic later, and that we reach out to the staff to offer support. It also crosses the line of the staff remit. Education Officer - 'I think as well that this falls between the staff and Directors, and probably more so to the Directors. Aswell the staff is under a lot of stress at the moment so I'd park it until after regional councils and then after regional councils go to the student advisory directors about it.'

Uachtarán Oinigh - proposes that we revisit this after the regional council season when both ourselves and the staff have more capacity.

Motion is passed with no objections, we will revisit this matter after Regional Councils season.

**10 - Freedom of Expression Stance -** Equality and Welfare Officers Uachtarán received an email regarding if the ISSU has a stance on body piercings. We currently do not have a stance on this so both the equality and welfare officers wish to develop a stance on.

#### **Proposed Stance:**

The ISSU holds the position that students' right to freedom of expression should be respected in education settings. This is laid out in the OBESSU declaration of School Students Rights (The school must respect the individuality of school students. Equality in education shall not mean uniformity: students have to be allowed to develop their personal abilities and identities towards the direction they want to.). In relation to piercings and other forms of self-expression such as but not limited In relation to piercings and other forms of self-expression such as but not limited to hair colour, hairstyles, and makeup, the ISSU believe students should have the right to freedom of expression unless there are genuine health and safety or other valid concerns.

Runaí - Directs questions to coiste gnó officers who have served on a previous coiste anó.

RLSO - issues to do with hijab bans and hair colours have previously been previously discussed by the coiste gnó but unsure about body piercing Communications - caution on the health and safety argument presented by schools however welcomes the stance.

Multiple Officers agreed with the points previously mentioned.

Equality officer - echos the extent of the issue.

International Officer - this issue is part of OBESSU policy so it is best practice to implement it.

Welfare - most important to create a stance since a student queried it. It will also help to support future projects on uniforms.

Uachtarán - echoes the points from the other officers

Runaí - would it be worth adding on religion expression to this stance of creating a separate official stance.
